Dear Pastor:

The Fifth Regional Conference of Baltimore and Vicinity will be held Wednesday and Thursday, October 17th and 18th, at Immanuel Church, Williamsport, Pennsylvania, Rev. H. Strub, Pastor. The conference begins at 2 P.M. on Wednesday afternoon, with an hour and a half allowed for the noon meal and registration before the opening session at 2 P.M.

Representation to the conference is constituted as follows:

1. Pastor
2. One official delegate from:
 - a. Church Council
 - b. Women's Organization
 - c. Brotherhood or Men's Organization
 - d. League or Young People's Organization
 - e. Sunday School or Religious Education Organization
 - f. As many un-official delegates as desire to attend

Traveling expenses of out-of-town delegates will be prorated among the official delegates. The registration fee for all official delegates will be \$2.00 each. Un-official delegates will be required to pay for their meals at the rate of 50¢ each.

Kindly see that all of your church organizations elect or appoint delegates. Attention is called to the following motion passed at a previous conference regarding representation:

"Anyone who is registered as representing some organization in the church is an official delegate and must participate in the pro-ration of the traveling expenses. Pastors automatically represent the churches to which they minister and must share traveling expenses alike with the lay delegates. The conference will require from all those ministers, laymen and other delegates of the churches not attending, a written excuse, or in default of which they shall be required to share in the equalization of the traveling expenses."

Arrangements have been made to carry delegates from Baltimore to Williamsport by bus, the cost being \$3.40 per person the round trip. Delegates from Richmond, Annapolis, Washington, D. C., Stemmers Run, and Cambridge can travel with Baltimore delegates by bus if desired. ALL reservations for the bus trip must be in the hands of the secretary not later than October 10, 1934. Time and place of destination of bus will be announced later. IF DELEGATES FROM OUT-OF-TOWN DESIRE TO TRAVEL IN BUS, COMMUNICATE AT ONCE WITH THE SECRETARY.
