German United Evangelical Church,

Dear Sirs,-

. Due to the overruling of your Finance Committee and its setup of the present year's Budget by the 69 members voting in the affirmative at our last Congregational Meeting of the 12th. Inst. and defying our constitution & by-laws relative to the above mentioned facts, I hereby tender my resignation as your Financial Secretary and all other committees on which you have appointed me to serve to become effective immediately.

In my humble estimation it is a pity indeed that the known facts that have occurred in the past ten years or more have born no fruit whatever or lesson taught whereby one might carry on the future.

The very principles laid by God and saved through the crucifixion of Our Saviour, that of Faith, Hope, Charity, Truthfulness and Honesty of Purpose and a will to go on to that end have no basic foundations whatever to find root herein.

I as a member of this Board have tried conscientiously and with untiring effort to uphold the above mentioned principles and adhere to and abide by your Constitution & By-laws as any uprighteous man that has been elected to serve this or any other board whether church, firm, corporation or whatever institution it may be.

I do not care to be one of a party of or even a witness to any organization that tears asunder the very fundamental principles upon which it stands.

I hope, I shall always possess firmness and virtue enough to maintain what I consider the most enviable of all titles, that the character of
