Mr. Waters, who had been elected by the congregation to investigate conditions surrounding Mr. Missel reported that Mr. Missel owned no property what-so-ever, except the house in which he lives. His only income was 233.26 annually from some bonds. for example

Board of Trustees inspected parsonage and found that entire building needed papering and paint work needed cleaning. Bids were ordered ^{to be placed} ~~paid~~ made for all work done.

At this time (9.30 P.M.) our President Mr Mueller arrived and took charge of the meeting.

Mrs. Lena Nalley requested the use of the church and hall for the morning and afternoon of March 14 for a convention meeting. Motion by Mr. Getz and seconded by Mr. William same be granted was carried.

Mr. Milton Sahlman requested that several benches in the church be reserved some time in March for the boys brigade. Motion by Mr. Buechler and seconded by Mr. Single the request be granted was carried.

Upon complaint of several members of the board over the fact that Mr. Winkler kept members of the Sunday School outside and would not permit them to enter causing confusion in the vestibule of the church, a committee of three consisting of Messrs. Mueller, Buechler and Williams was appointed to instruct Mr. Winkler that this practice must be stopped for the benefit of everybody concerned.

Mr. Getz, briefly gave an outline of the entire cost of rebuilding and repairing the parsonage porch and various other work on the building. The total cost was \$283.80.

Nothing else claiming the attention of the board, the same adjourned with the repeating in unison of the Lord's Prayer
