


Wednesday, March 23, 1960

Wednesday, March 16, 1960

A special meeting was called at 9:30 P. M.

In attendance was Rev. Lehmann, George Hammerbacher, Ernest Jones, Norman Fritze, George Smith, John Will, William Bark, Maxim Hoffmann, Albert Fader, Mark Strovel.

The special meeting was called of the Church Council by President Albert Fader, to follow through on recommendations made by the Congregation at the recent Congregational Meeting.

The meeting opened with a discussion to consider a full time secretary to replace Mrs. Elma Amrhien, who has notified the Church Council that she is anxious to resign her position immediately after Easter. Several possibilities were discussed fully and it narrowed down to the fact that the person should be someone vitally interested in the welfare of the Church.

It was decided that before any action be taken an announcement should be made at both services on Sunday, March 20, asking for anyone interested to contact the Pastor or members of the Church Council. The salary is to start at \$50.00 and if proper attitude, aptitude and ability is shown it could be increased gradually to a top \$60.00 per week. The work week will consist of five days a week and the hours from 9 to 4.

The subject of snow removal from the sidewalks around the Church and Parsonage was discussed and it was decided to contact the Boy Scouts of the Church, along this line. Mr. Fader and Mr. Hammerbacher were appointed to make this contact and report back to the Board.

Upon a motion by Mark Strovel it was moved and unanimously carried, seconded by George Hammerbacher, that Pastor Lehmann's salary be increased as of April 1st to the figure recommended at the Congregational Meeting of \$6500.00 per annum and further that any emolument or gratuities which he may receive be turned over to the Church.

Meeting was adjourned at 10:15 P. M.
