COMMUNICATIONS - None.



A motion was made by Mr. Jorio, seconded by Mr. Laukeman that we hold our first early Sunday service the first Sunday after Easter. It has been suggested that we open this service at 8:15, if possible, but that the Pastor use his own discretion in deciding this matter.

NEW BUSINESS - It has been brought to our attention that several of the older members of the congregation have some difficulty in hearing the sermon. It has been suggested that we look into the possibility of perhaps having an amplifier installed under the Balcony of the Church.
