Dear Mr. Frankhanel :

In regards to your suggestions and proposals at the council meeting on Tuesday September 15, 1953 the council voted as follows.

Subject:- Vacations for choir members.

The council voted against this. Suggesting that choir member take a vacation when and if they so desire.

Subject :- Vacations for organist and choir director.

The council voted that the organist and choir director are entitled to four weeks vacation. These cannot be taken at the same time. They cannot be taken at SPECIAL Services. In the absence of the choir director the organist will take care of the choir.

Subject:- Paid Quartet and paid solists.

The council voted against having to pay anyone to sing in the church choir.

Subject :- Repairing old music.

Mr. Frank Hutchinson will donate all of the material you need to do this. Rev. Lehmann suggested that we would get the Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts and Brownies to help you with this work.

Subject :- Funds for new music.

When you wish to get any new music . The Council has a music committee. Get in touch with them and they will help you to take care of this. The church will pay for all music that is approved by the music committee.


Subject:- Summer Services.

The council voted to have a choir at both services in the summer. They suggested that you may work it so that the choir will rehearse every other week in the summer.

Subject:- Choir rehearsals.

The council leaves this up to you and the choir members. What ever it agreed on by both parties is alright with the council.
