

June 9th - 1935

A special Board meeting was called on the evening of the above date with Pres. Geo. Trautner presiding.

President Trautner explained to the board that members of the congregation had complained to him over the fact that no delegate had been appointed to accompany Rev. Lehman to attend the Atlantic District Conference along with Rev. Lehman. After some discussion as to who could attend and finding that none of the board members were in a position to go it was decided to allow the Pastor and President Trautner to select some one who could attend.

The question of sending half of the Benevolence to the synod was raised and after being informed that our Constitution gave the finance committee control over this matter and that the budget for the year had been accepted by the congregation, it was decided to send 50% to the synod immediately.

The board also granted Rev. Lehman a month vacation also informing him that it was his duty to see that the pulpit was properly filled while he was absent. Rev. Lehman accepted this favor with thanks.
