A special ~~Bo~~ meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on the evening of the above date with President Geo. Trautner presiding.

Prayer was offered by Mr. Howard Zimmerman.

President Trautner gave as the purpose for the meeting the lack of attendance at the 6 A.M. Sunday service. The President then asked for a discussion by the members of the Board as to the wisdom of continuing the 6 O'Clock service. It was pointed out that due to the small attendance the early service has proven to be a large financial failure during the three Sundays it had been tried.

Mr. Zimmerman made a motion to combine the 6 A.M. Service with the 10.⁰⁵ service which was seconded by Mr. Buechler. The Board passed this motion to take effect as of July 28th 1935.
