To The Church Council & Members Of Congregation Of G.U.E.C.:-

In  
reference to the motion made, seconded and passed upon by the  
Congregation at the regular quarterly congregational meeting  
as of the 14th. inst. relative to an increase in your pastor's  
salary to \$2500.00 a year effective July 1st.

We, the undersigned deem it unadvisable at this time  
under your present financial conditions and bearing in mind  
the fact you are contemplating a huge building project in the  
very near future, in granting the above said increase.

We likewise herein wish to state most emphatically and  
stress the point that this said motion is altogether contrary  
to the rules and by-laws of this your church.

However to satisfy this group of less than 10% of your  
voting members present at this meeting, we grant all monies of  
your present year's income over and above your budget allotment  
of \$6836.00 and not in excess of the \$125.00, to cover the  
above mentioned increase.

Please remember that the above budget allotment was  
presented to the church council in December and approved and  
likewise to the congregational meeting in the same month and  
adopted.
