We give you below the quotas as prepared by your Finance Committee and approved by the District Council for your Congregation for the year 1934 for both Synod and District.

The District Quota is based on a budget \$1,200.00

Two blanks are sent to your pastor for execution by the Church Council, if that body has the authority to accept the quota or by execution by the body which has the power to do so. Return both to Henry W. Schultheis, 3721 Edmondson Avenue, Baltimore, Md., not later than November 25th, 1933. We ask your earnest and prayerful consideration of this matter, and trust that your Congregation will accept the quotas as assigned.

Should your congregation desire an explanation of this budget, it will be cheerfully given if you will write to the undersigned, who will have some one who is acquainted with this work visit your congregation or your church council. His expenses will be defrayed from the district treasury.

The work of God's Kingdom must not be retarded, and it is our duty to see that the Work is kept moving. We invite your attention in this connection to St. Paul's Epistle to the Galatians, Chapter 6, for study and action. Let us place our faith in Him.
