7. Whatever happened to the warm welcome, handshake, etc. that prevailed in the old church building?
8. The mail is sometimes forwarded to old address, 8 N. Highland Ave.
9. Would you please sing "I Need Thee Every Hour" in the near future? Note: Hymn was included in service of June 5th.
10. You don't state on these forms where they are to be left when filled out.
11. I'm using Ronald's envelopes while he is away in service.
12. I think the choir should sing more of the old anthems that are more familiar with the congregation.
13. My daughter asked Rev. Lehmann for my envelopes this year as there were none there when they were in the Friendship Hall.
