Mr. Fritze then brought up the idea of Church purchasing their own runner to be used for weddings. Mr. Fritze is to look into price on this and report back to Council.

Pastor Jasche advised the walls of the parsonage should be washed every year and paint applied when needed. Mr. Fader will take a look at the walls.

Mr. Sauer will check into having the grass plots in front of garage cemented and some shrubbery placed in front of garage.

A motion was made by Mr. Sill Park to purchase utility cabinet for dictaphone in office at a cost of \$15.00. Seconded by Fred Long.

Mr. Bond stated that we have 220 current up to rooms where air conditioners are to be installed. The only problem is - Is the line strong enough to carry the 220.

Pasta Pasch inquired as to whether air conditioner that Ecker has repaired could be used in Choir Room.

Mr. Bond is to check the status of this air conditioner.
