New Business - Mr. Mueller appointed the Committees for the year 1950.

A motion was made by Mr. Laukeman, seconded by Mr. Bauersfeld that we change the Lenten Evening Services from Friday nights to Wednesday nights with the Amendment by Mr. Fischer providing it meets with the approval of the majority of the congregation. Cards will be printed and given out at the Christmas Eve Service to be marked whether you desire Wednesday or Friday nights and to be signed by the members. The tentative budget for 1950 was presented and a motion was made by Mr. Gross, seconded by Mr. Hutchinson that we accept the budget as read.

Our Sunday Evening services are getting to be somewhat of a problem. The attendance seems to be declining all the time and much thought and consideration should be given this by the entire congregation.
