With all His grace and His favor.

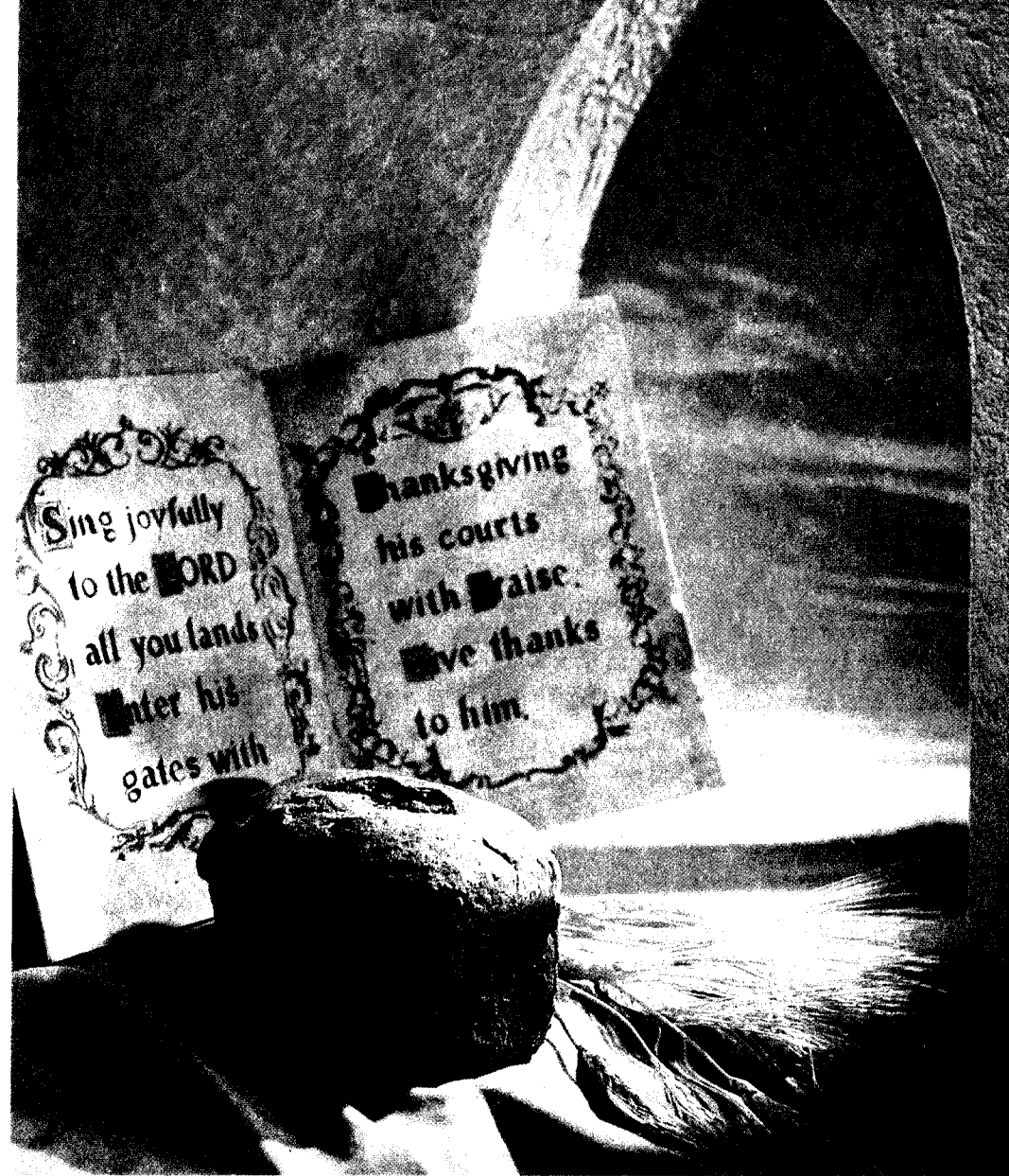
Here stands the font before our eyes
